The Teen and Queen winners must be present for Tuesday's opening ceremony as well as Friday and Saturday activities and are welcome to take part in each day's activities. The horse show will take place on July 27th and all winners are encouraged to attend to pass out trophies and ribbons. The Queen must be available to compete in the Miss WV Association of Fairs & Festivals pageant in January 2020. If for any reason she is unable to represent the Wayne County Fair at the state pageant she must relinquish her title, crown, sash and prize package to the first runner-up.

The phases of competition for all contestants will be:

Personal Style: All contestants will wear jeans with their choice of shirt/blouse, shoes, and accessories. Let the judges see your personality through your choice of attire.

Evening Gown: This is the most beautiful phase of the competition. During the evening gown phase is when the on-stage question will be asked.

Interview: Contestants will be wearing jeans for this phase of competition. We encourage you to wear a different shirt/blouse than what you wear in the Personal Style phase of the competition.

Queen prize package includes crown, plaque, custom sash, flowers, \$500 scholarship paid when successor is crowned, lodging and entry fee paid to the Miss WV Association of Fairs & Festivals Pageant, 2 guest tickets to the Miss WV Association of Fairs & Festivals Pageant, and more.

Teen prize package includes crown, plaque, custom sash, flowers, \$250 scholarship paid when successor is crowned, 2 guest tickets to the Miss WV Association of Fairs & Festivals Pageant, and more. Teen must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian while attending the convention.

First, Second and Third Runner-Up in all age divisions will receive a plaque.

Awards will be given for Photogenic and Congeniality in each age division.

Packets will be emailed to contestants the week leading up to the pageant. Pageant day schedule will be outlined in the packet.
